- Poster session is quite popular in any conference. Most of contributed papers are presented as posters.

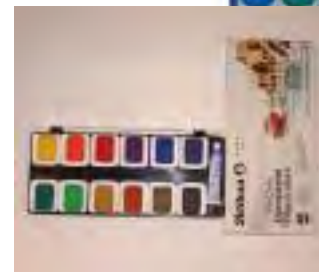


Poster session provides a good chance to discuss minutely on our achievements of the studies.

Traveling with a drawing set

- Whenever I make travels overseas, I take a small sketchbook and a set of drawing materials with me: A portable water-color set, a brush-washing vessel and a water-resistant marker.

Only with paper and brush

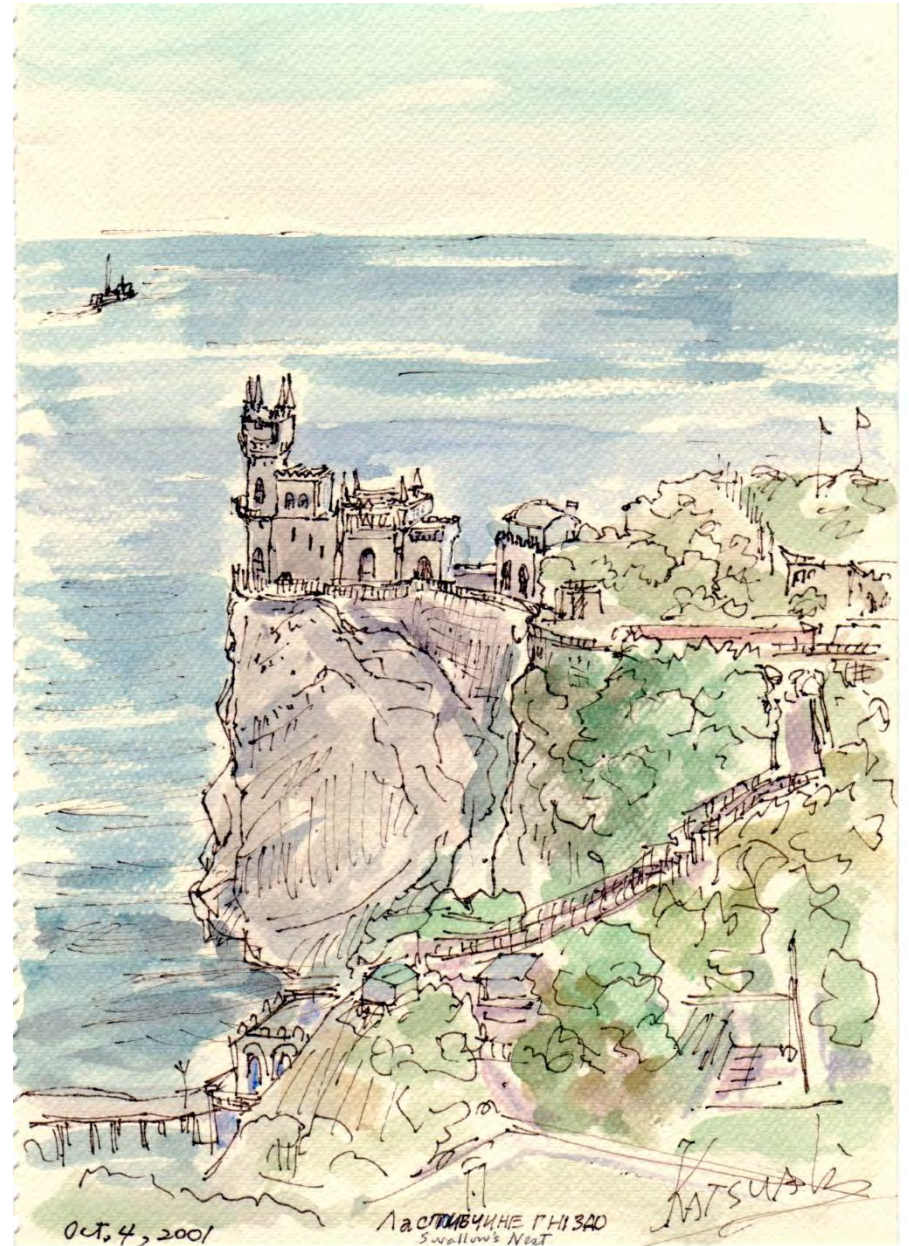
- You can draw wherever you are only if you have 20 or 30 minutes to spend.
- You can make friends of the location.



Only 20-30 minutes

- Usually oral and poster presentations of international conferences are scheduled from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. In Europe at summer time everywhere is bright until 8:00 pm. So we have lot of time to spend for sketches after five.
- First I draw landscapes with a water-resistant marker pen on a sheet of the sketchbook, then I color with a brush in the drawing set. I take only 20 to 30 minutes in total to finish the painting. Therefore I can finish more than three drawings every day.

- I had enough time to sketch passengers.



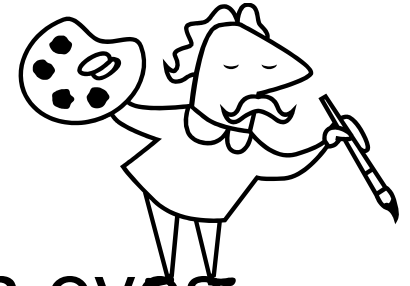
Communication through internet

- The picture in the left was asked by the Monastery of Notre Dame des Anges to be used as an illustration for the top page of their website.



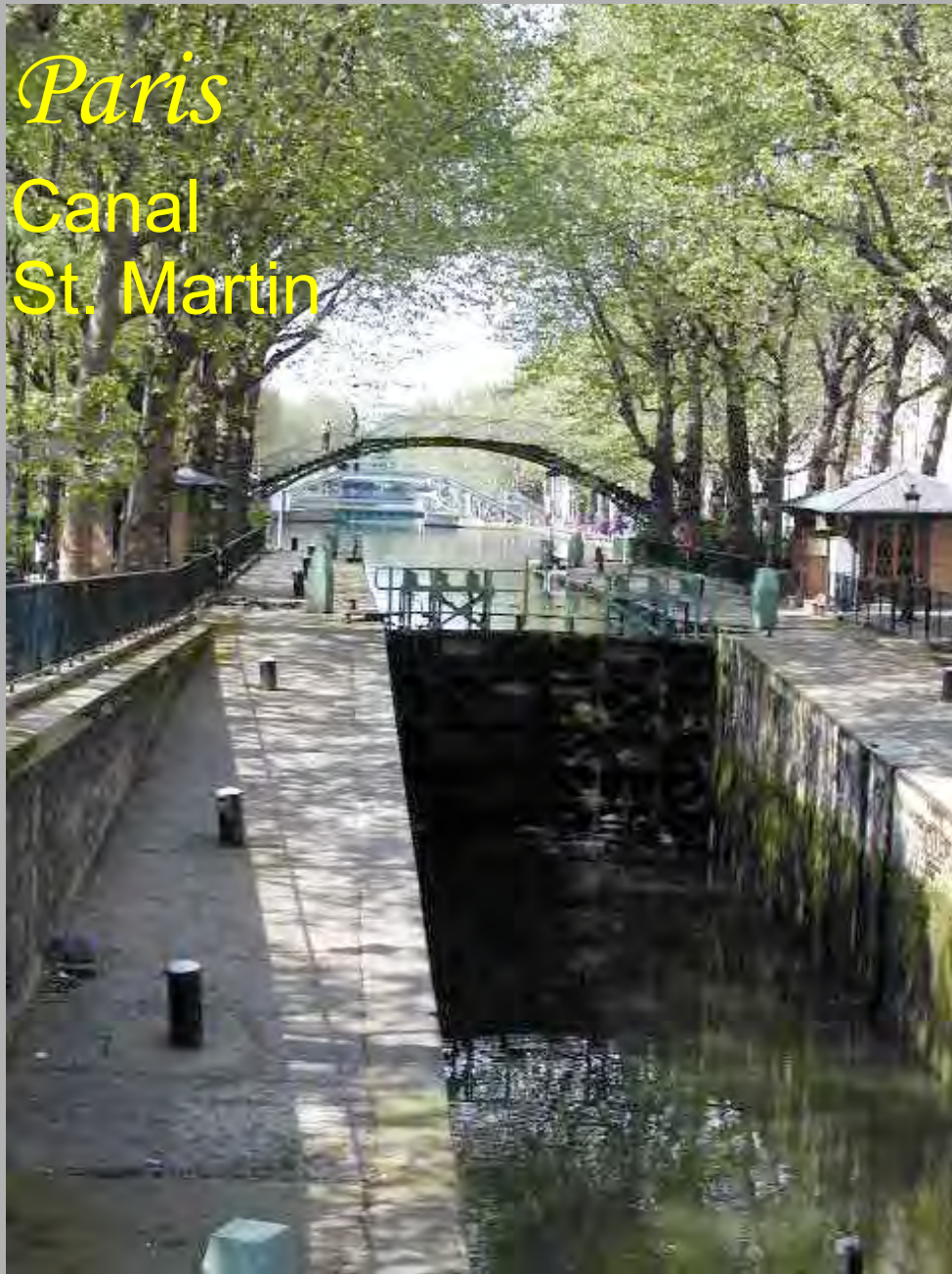


Photo and drawing

- You may have an experience that you find a moon bigger when it just appears, than when it is high in the sky.

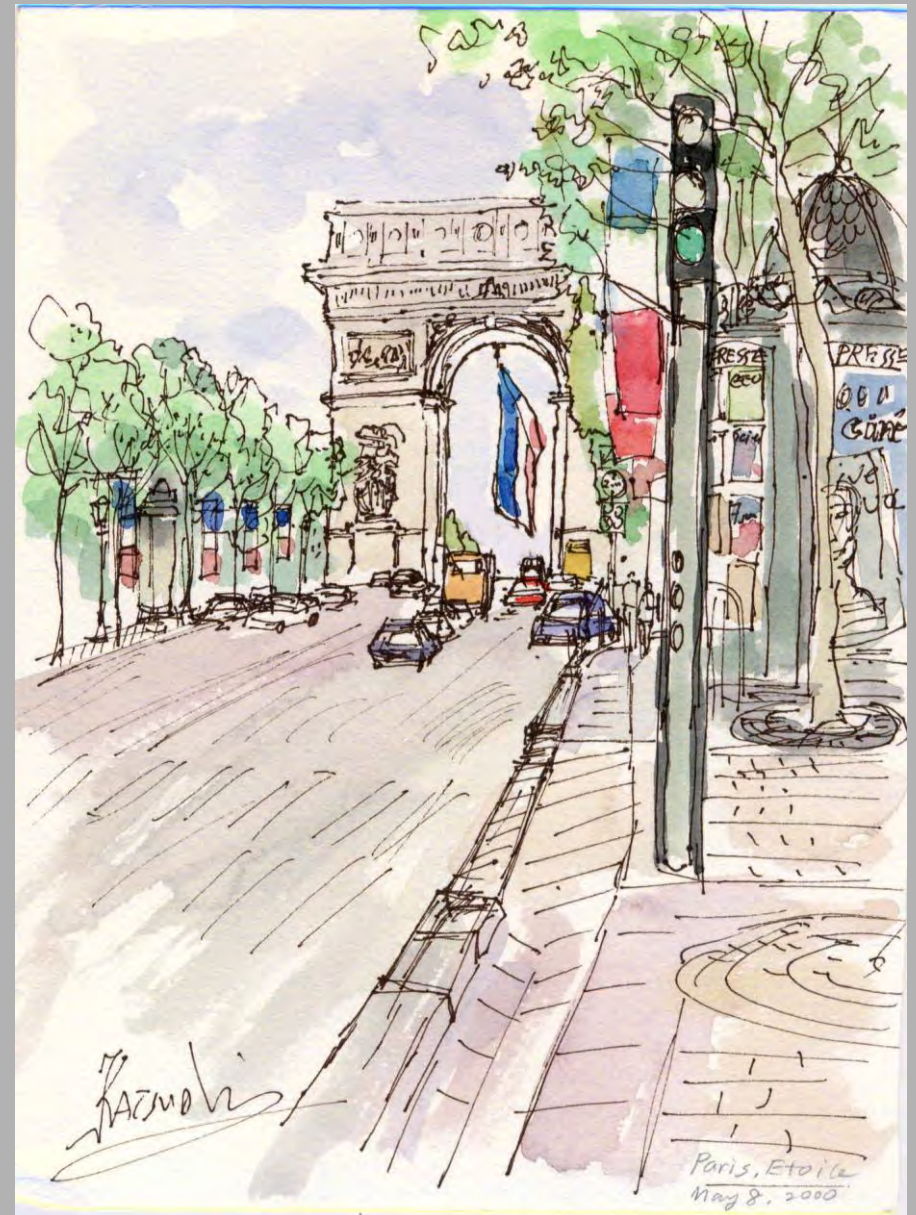

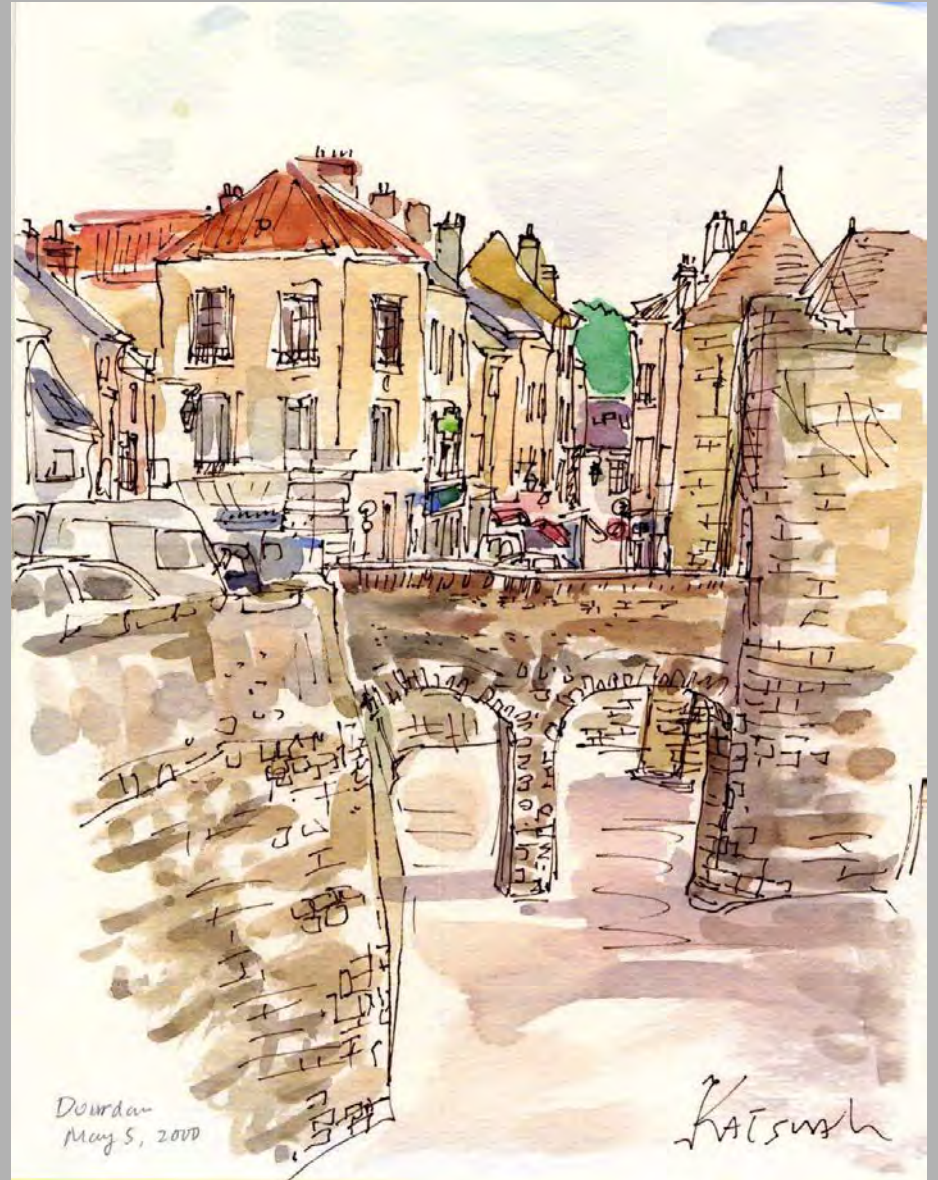

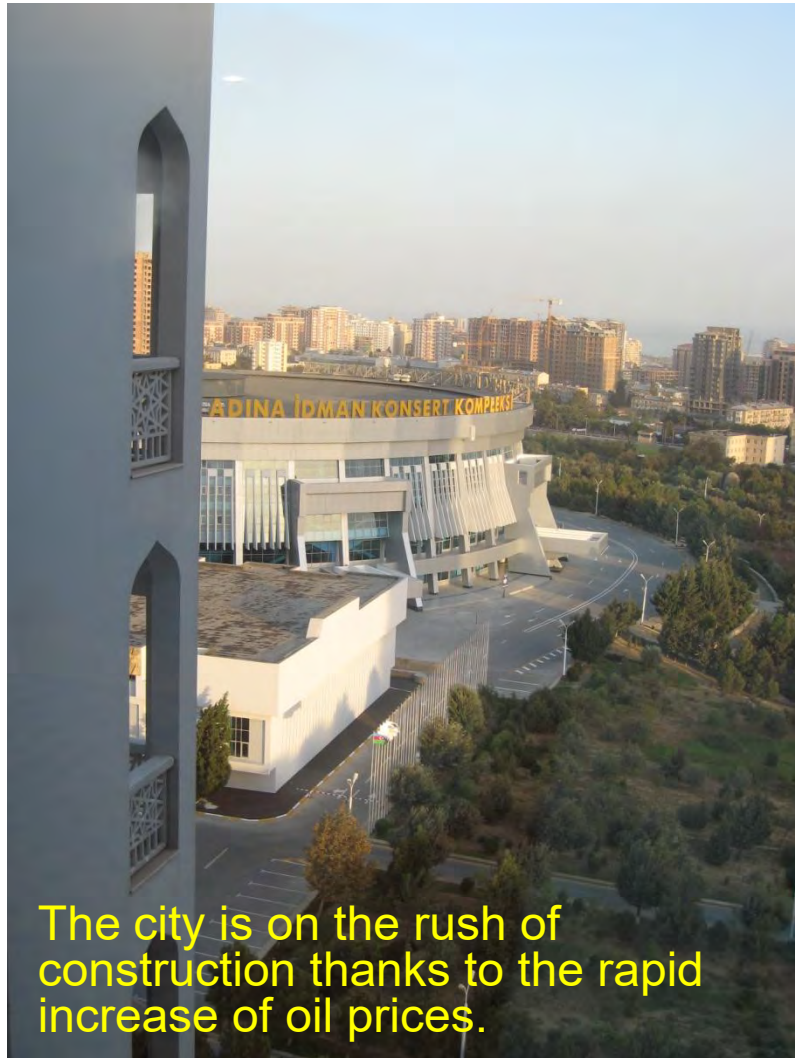

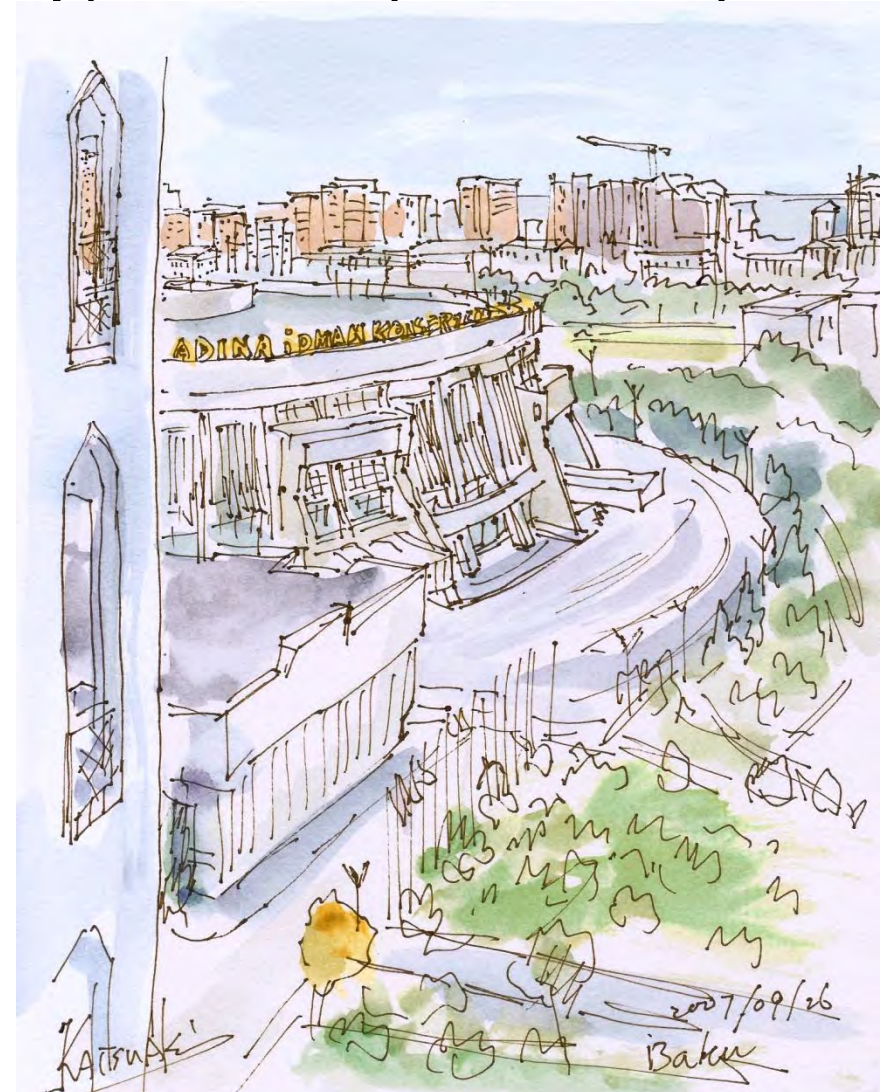


- Reception was organized at the Yacht House on Baku Bay.

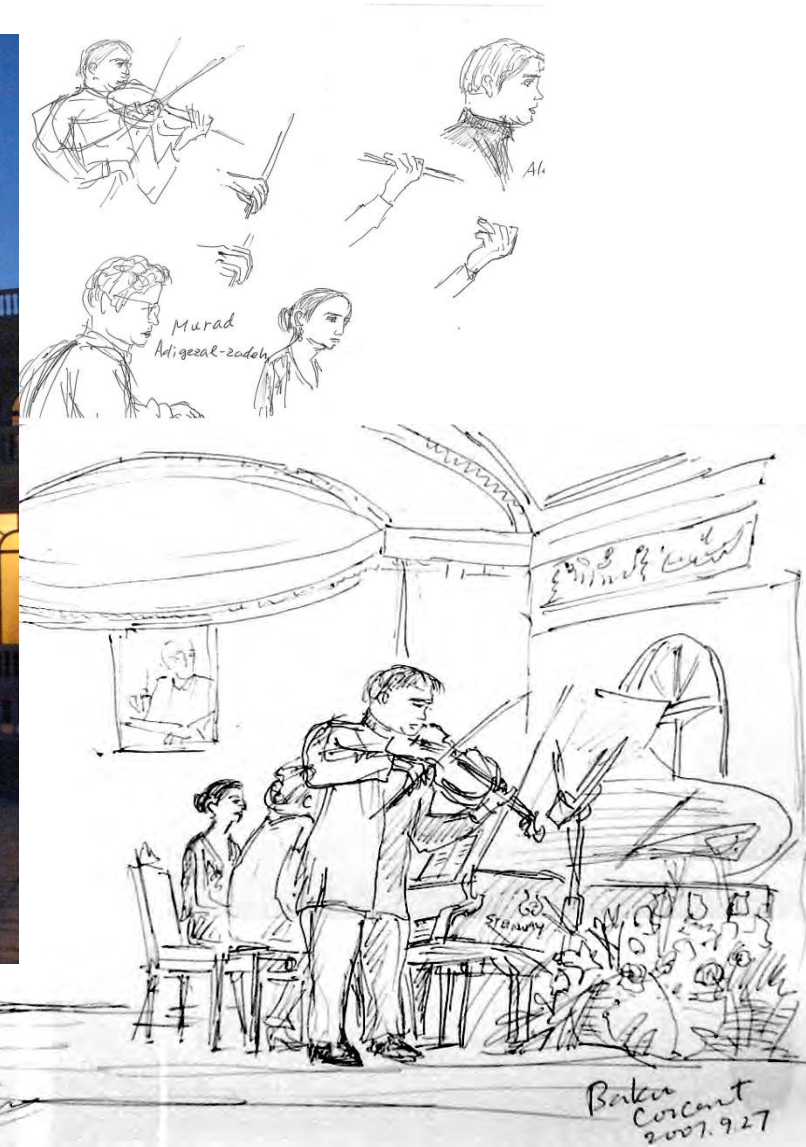

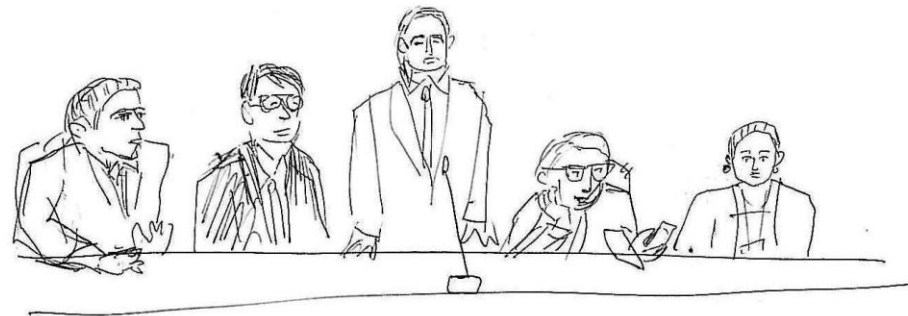

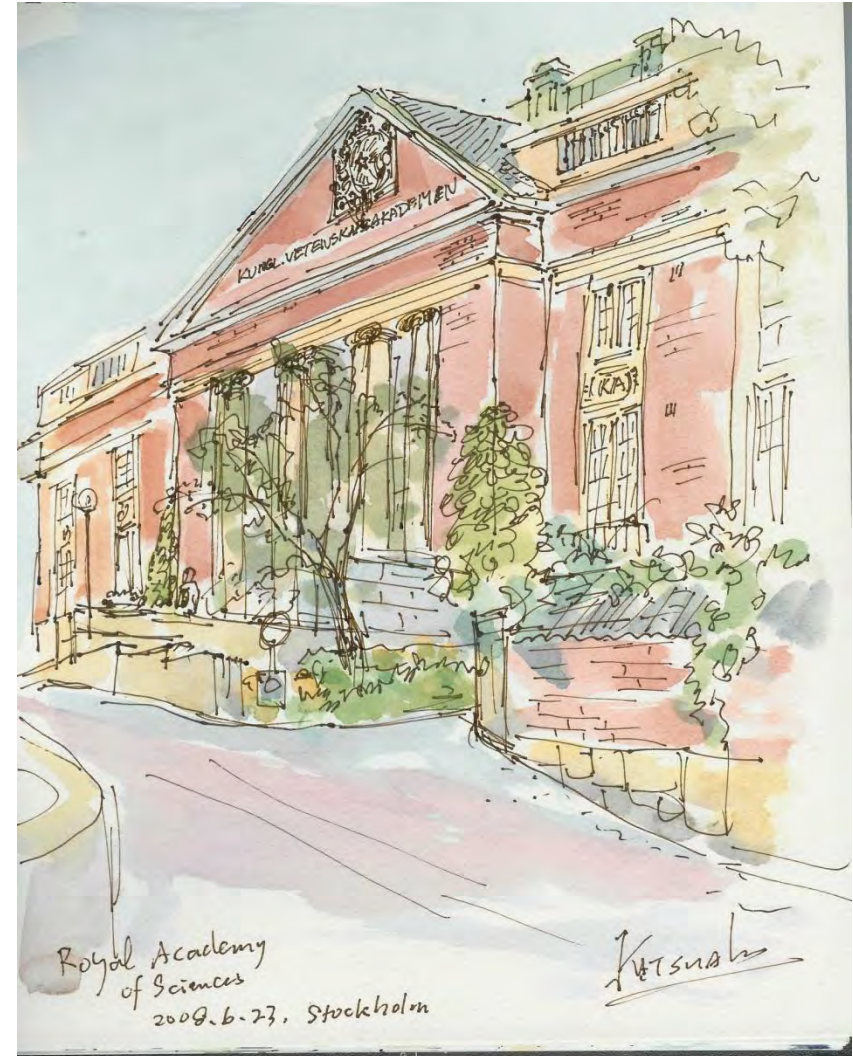

- Many sight-seeing boats as well as ferry boats leave from or arrive at the harbour.

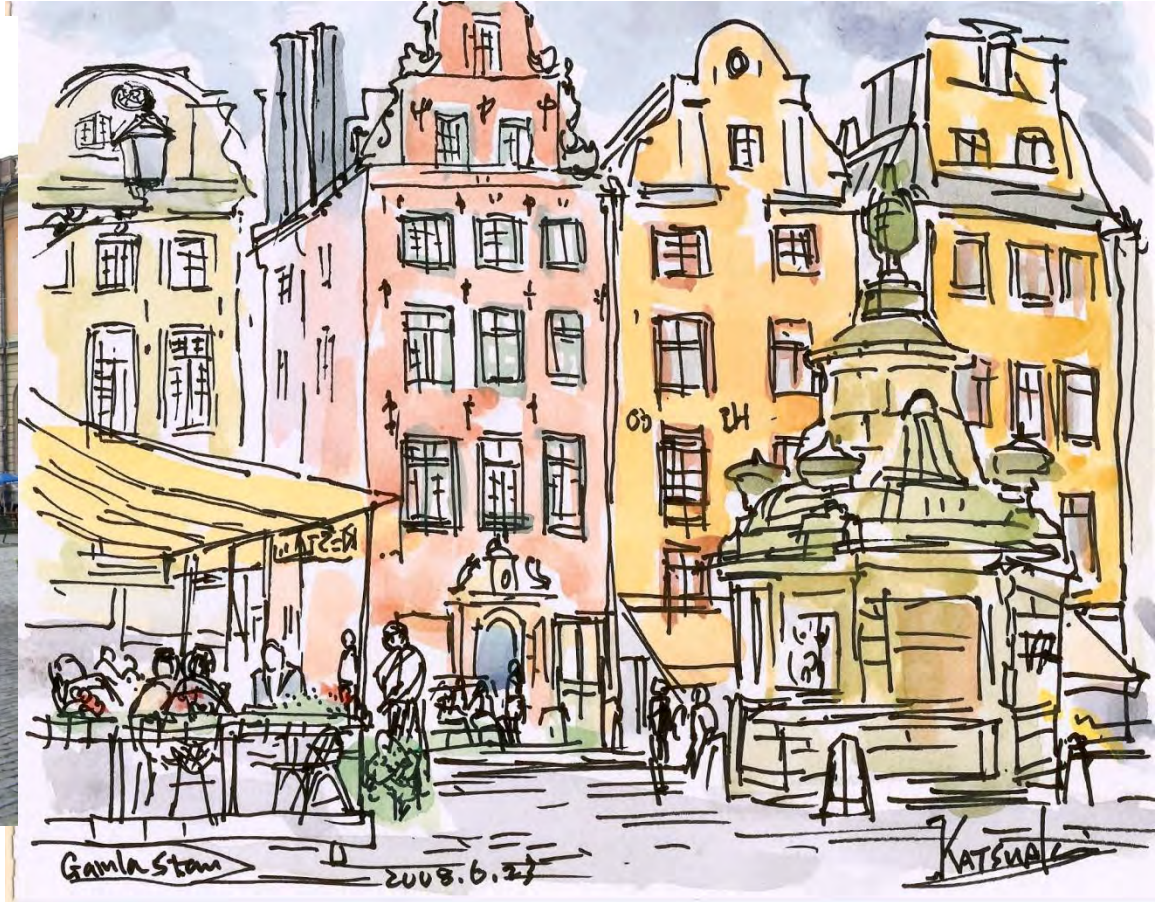

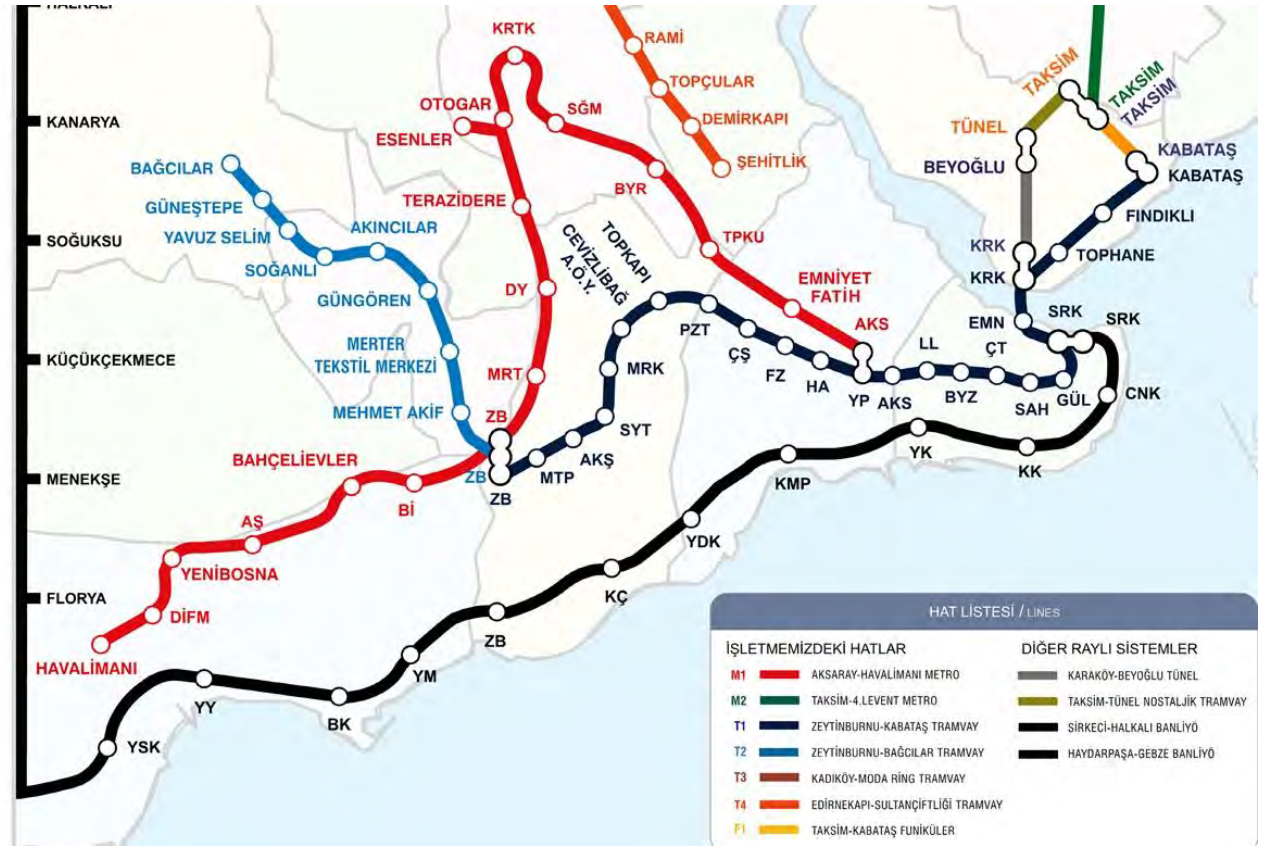

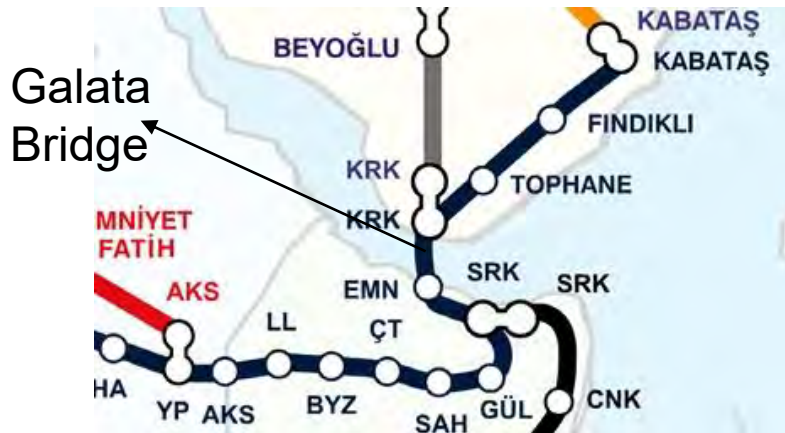

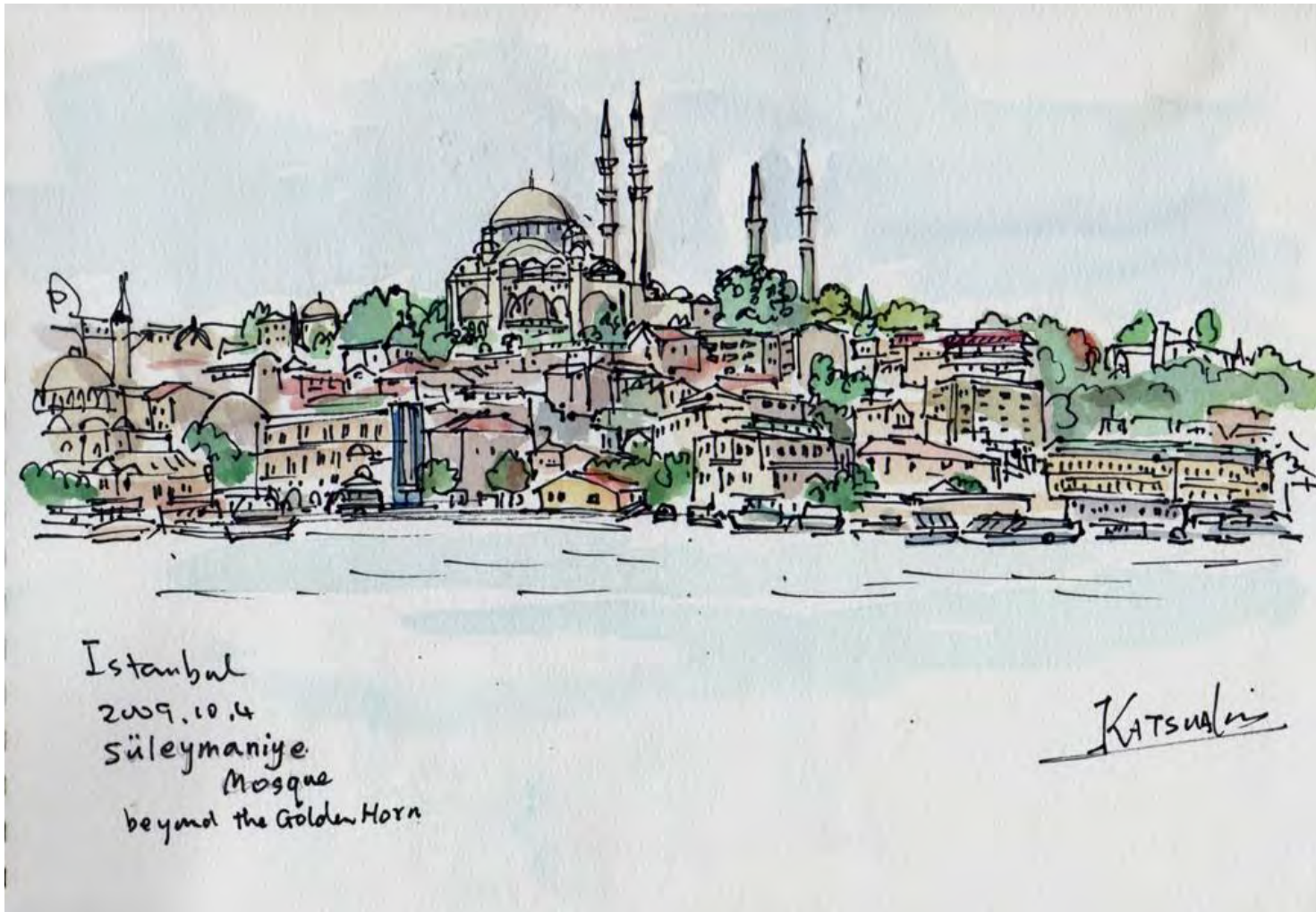
